Admission to exhibit is free.

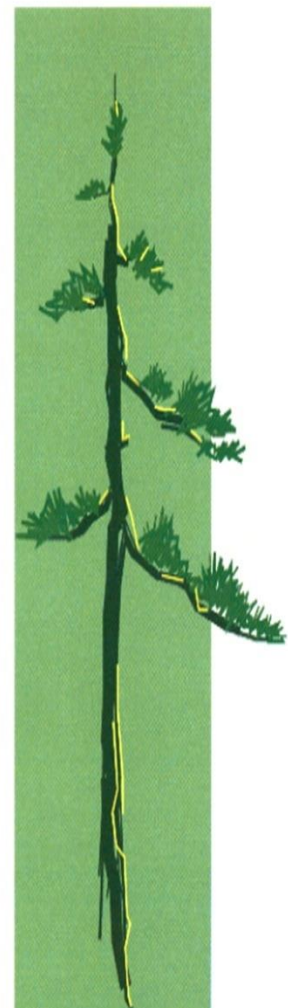
