## Thank you for volunteering!

We rely on volunteers to ensure that we have a successful event. Areas needing volunteers include the following:

- **Exhibit:** Help set up tables and skirting, check in the exhibit trees, and help exhibitors tear down and clean up their areas.
- **Friday Kids:** Several schools will bus student to participate in the Folk Fair on Friday. Volunteers are needed to help stamp Holiday Folk Fair passports. MBS has a number of ink stamps available to stamp the passports the kids bring to the bonsai exhibit.
- **Security:** Make certain that the exhibit area is secure during the daily events.

## Frequently Asked Questions:

**Where should I park and does it cost?** At Wisconsin State Fair Park there are many entrances to the parking lots. Park in the lot closest to the State Fair Park Exposition Center. There will be State Fair employees directing traffic. There is a fee for parking.

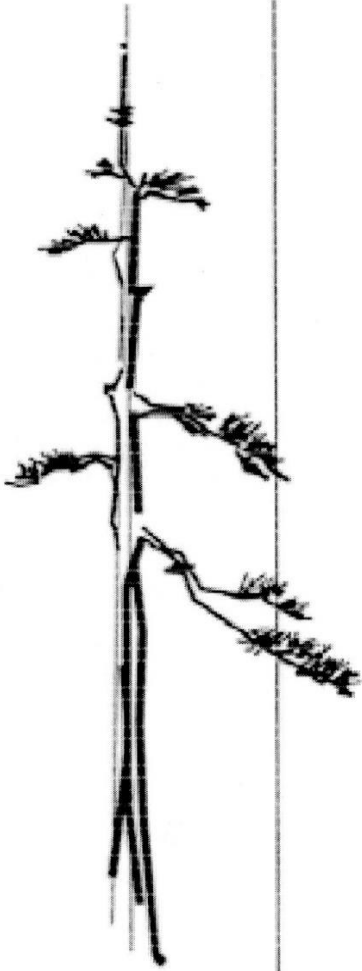
**Do I need a ticket to enter?** You will need to check in at the Volunteer Booth inside the entrance of the Exposition Center. Your name will be on a list of volunteers from MBS. No fee is charged for volunteers and as a bonus you will be provided a Holiday Folk Fair volunteer pin at the booth.

**Is lunch provided?** All meals and beverages are on your own. There are many ethnic food booths providing a large variety of foods to try.

**Should I wear my badge?** Yes, please wear your MBS badge. If you have not picked it up at a meeting a blank self-stick badge will be available.

**Where should I look for to get assigned work?** The exhibit is against a back wall in the far exhibit area (past the food area). There you will find tables and chairs with flyers to provide guest.
